General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) Notice

Mocse Federal Credit Union Credit Union is committed to complying with the spirit of the GDPR for our members who reside in the European Union. Notwithstanding any California or federal privacy policy or privacy notice we send you, please be advised that as long as your address in our records is within an EU country, we will store, process and share the data we collect about you with third parties only for the following purposes: (a) to process transactions initiated on your Mocse accounts, (b) to provide you with periodic account activity statements and other notices and disclosures we are required by law to send you, (c) to comply with laws to which Mocse is subject, and (d) to monitor account activity for purposes of fraud risk reduction. We and third-party contractors acting on our behalf may collect data about you such as your name, address, U.S. taxpayer ID number, telephone number, e-mail address, date of birth, income and employment from your applications for our services. If you apply for or maintain account or loan services with Mocse, we can obtain information about your account and credit history from consumer reporting agencies and report our account and credit experience with you to consumer reporting agencies. By applying for or maintaining services with Mocse, you expressly agree that we and third parties with whom we contract to act on our behalf may collect, store, use and share your data for these stated purposes. You can withdraw your consent to our storage, use and sharing of your data for any of these purposes, but your withdrawal of consent may require us to discontinue the associated service.
